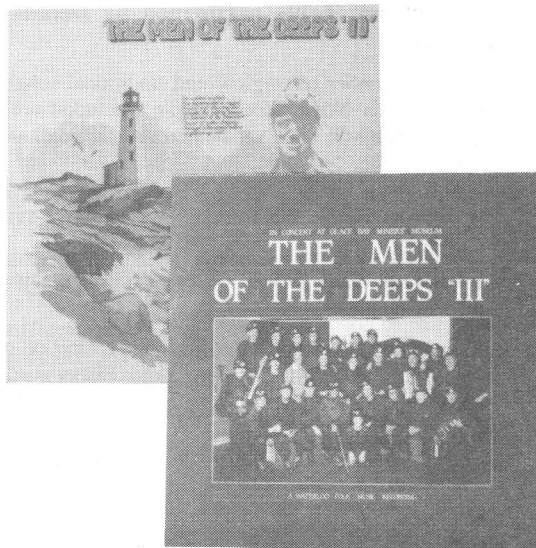

### Marie Hare of Strathadam, New Brunswick

A great cassette featuring this fine traditional singer from the Miramichi area of New Brunswick. Marie Hare learned her music from her family: "Marie likes to remember the winter nights, the black kitchen stove gleaming with polish, the kitchen floor scrubbed velvet white, the whole room glowing with warm from the hardwood fire. Chairs were drawn near the stove, the parents would teach the children the words of the songs, and drill them in the airs they knew so well. As the evening went on, neighbours would drop in and join the singing." From this has come a great traditional singer with a wonderful repertoire that is sampled on the cassette. This is a re-release of the original Folk Legacy album (FSC 9) and is part of the CFMS Cassette Production Programme. Documentation by Louise Manny and Edward Ives is included.
