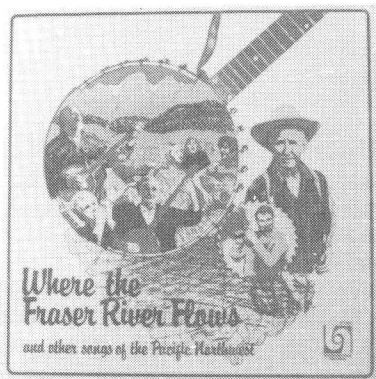


Songs (Mostly Traditional): Western Canada

Not long ago, most Canadians assumed that British Columbia was not a particularly rich source of folksong material, but Phil Thomas has changed this. He has amassed a large collection of material that has resulted in his fine book *Songs of the Pacific Northwest* (Vancouver, Hancock House, 1979) and this album which contains 19 of the 49 songs in the book. A wonderful variety of songs drawn from traditional through to composed tunes, revealing musical interpretations of the life and history of Canada's westernmost region.

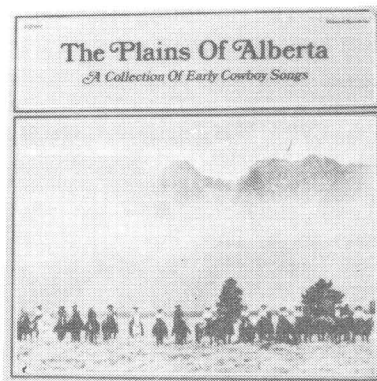

The Plains of Alberta: A Collection of Early Cowboy Songs

Is made up of re-pressings of old 78 RPM recordings of cowboy singers from the 1930s. Of particular interest are three cuts by Wilf Carter (Old Alberta Plains, The Cowboy's Heavenly Dream and Midnight the Unconquered Outlaw). In addition there are performances by John White, Tex Ritter, Edward L. Crain and Fred Kirby. Most of the songs on the album have been in active oral circulation in western Canada.
